Car-free Day & Mayor's Tea Party

This is proposed to be an exploration of what can be done in a car-free town centre. I see it as a great opportunity to actually meet our residents – the ones we don't know.

To enable this, it is proposed that we close streets as follows:

Close Thoroughfare	10:00 to 22:00
Close Quay and Church Streets	10:00 to 18:30
Close North end of Cumberland Street	10:00 to 18:30

This will allow us to create a 'Town Square' at the junction of Quay St and the Thoroughfare / Cumberland St, where the tea party could take place, with the Excelsior Band.

- Street Gardens – Transition Woodbridge
- Introduce Woodbridge Awards
- Soapbox
- Councillors Corner (like Speakers Corner).
